# TIMELINE

- Tests were administered March through May
- Online results began appearing mid-June
- First batch of Individual Student Score Reports received mid-July
- Preliminary results sent to sites end of July
- Remaining Individual Student Score Reports received mid-September
- Public release of CAASPP results on October 2, 2018

# WHAT TESTS DID STUDENTS TAKE?

Test	Content	Participants	Grade Levels
Smarter Balance Summative Assessments	ELA Mathematics	All students at designated grade levels*	3-8 and 11
California Alternate Assessments (CAA)	ELA Mathematics	Students with IEP indicating an alternate test	3-8 and 11
California Science Test (CAST) – Field Test	Science	All students at designated grade levels	5, 8 and one time in High School (grade 10, 11, or 12)
California Alternate Assessment for Science – Pilot Year 2	Science	Students with IEP indicating an alternate test	5, 8 and one time in High School (grade 10, 11 or 12)

\*Exceptions: Students whose IEP indicates use of alternate assessments and EL's in their first 12 months attending a school in the U.S. (ELA only). 3

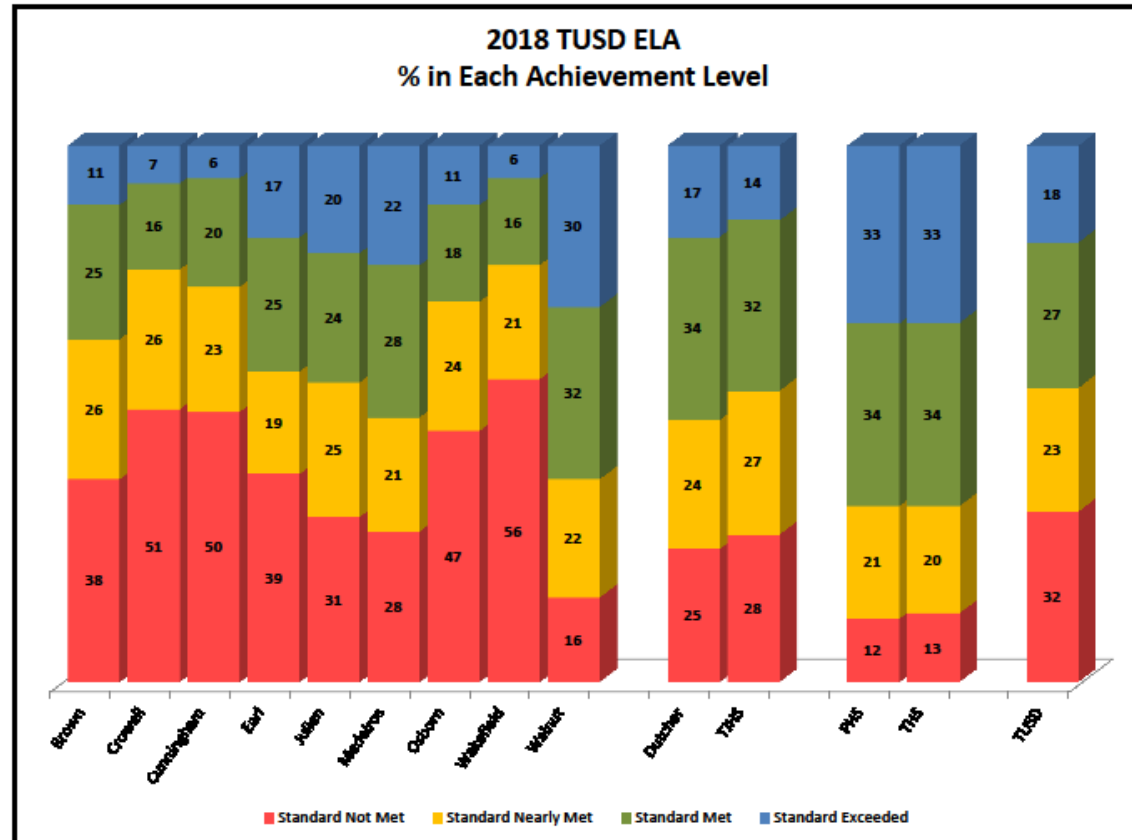

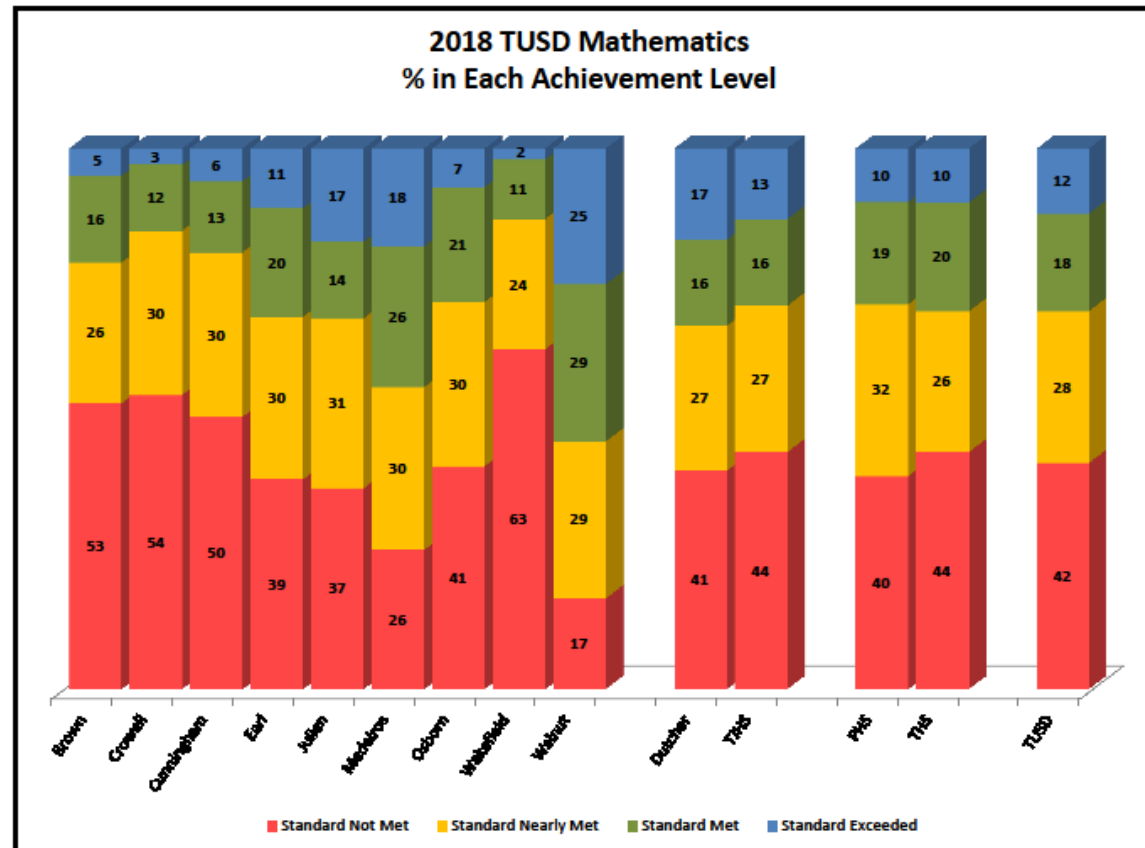




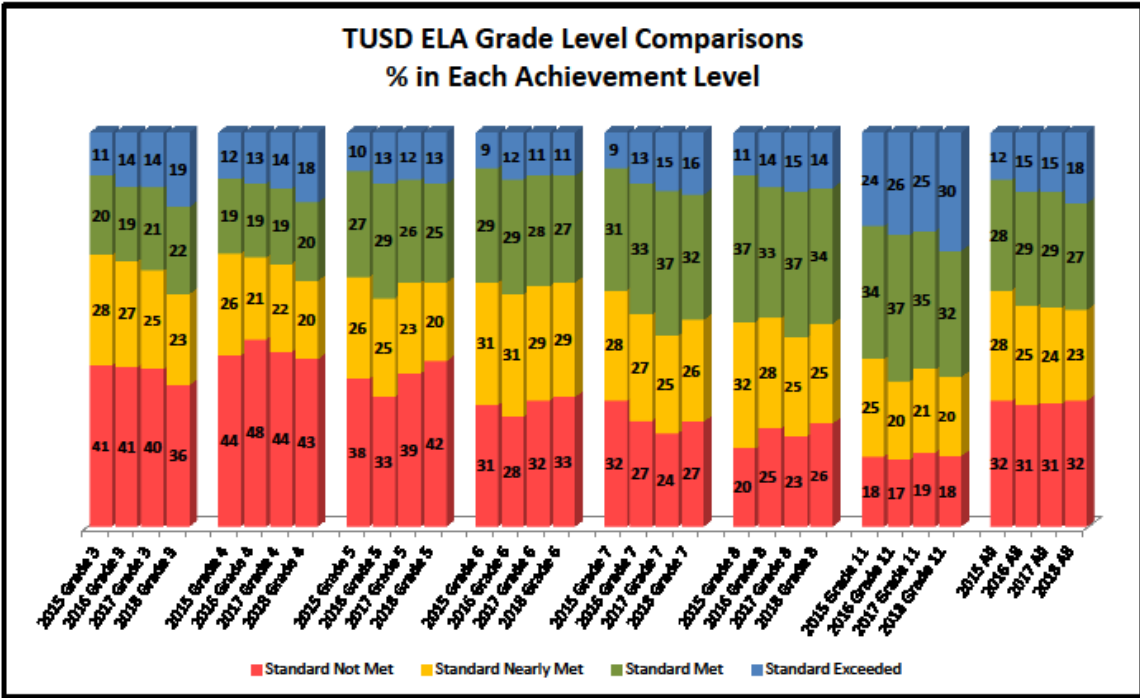
# 2018 ELA SITE RESULTS



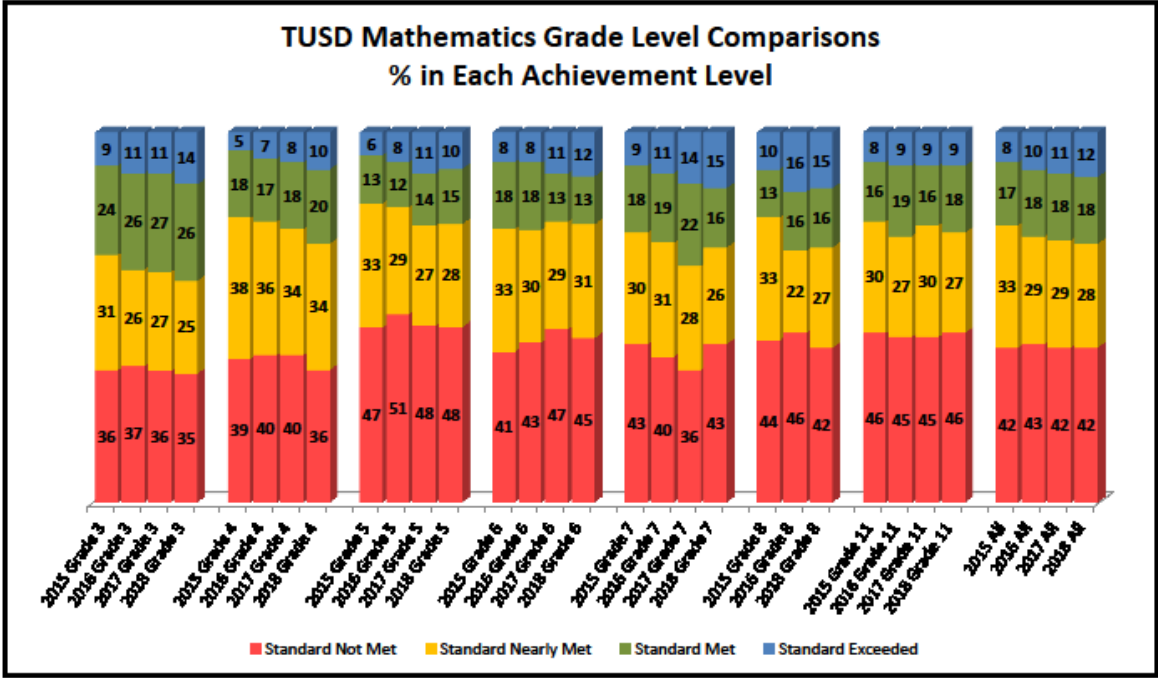
# 2018 MATHEMATICS SITE RESULTS



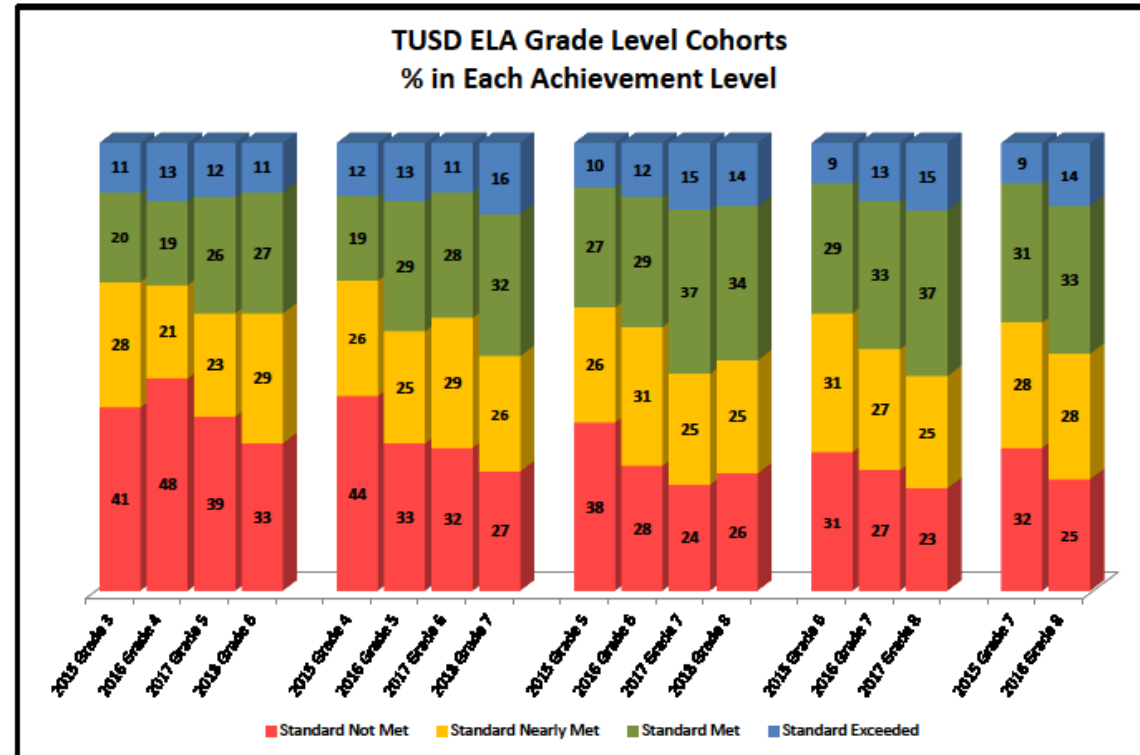
# ELA GRADE LEVEL RESULTS



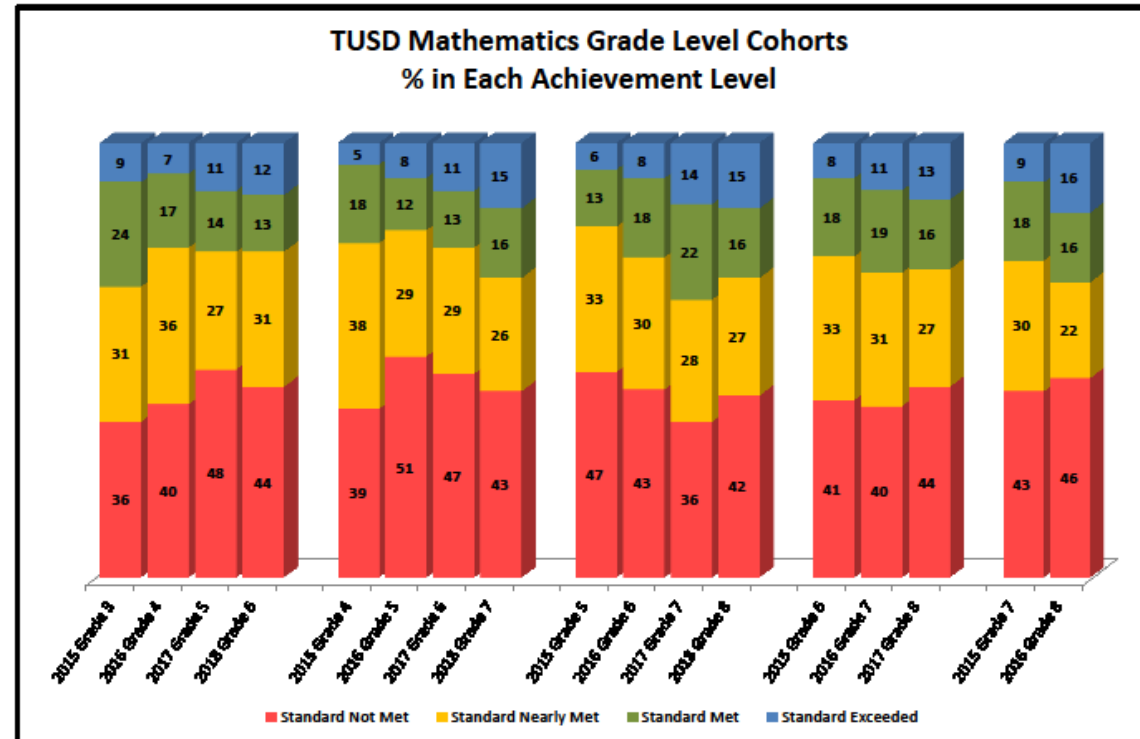
# MATHEMATICS GRADE LEVEL RESULTS



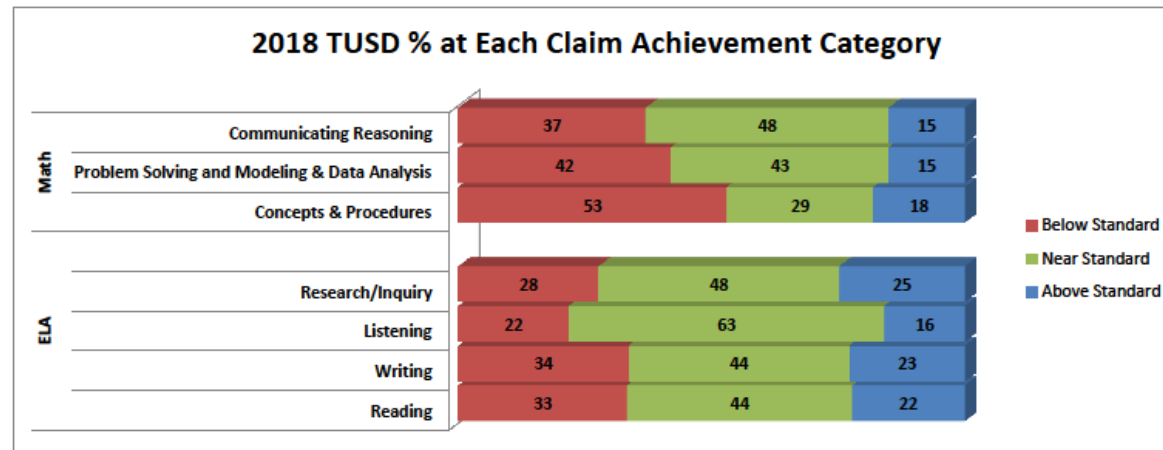

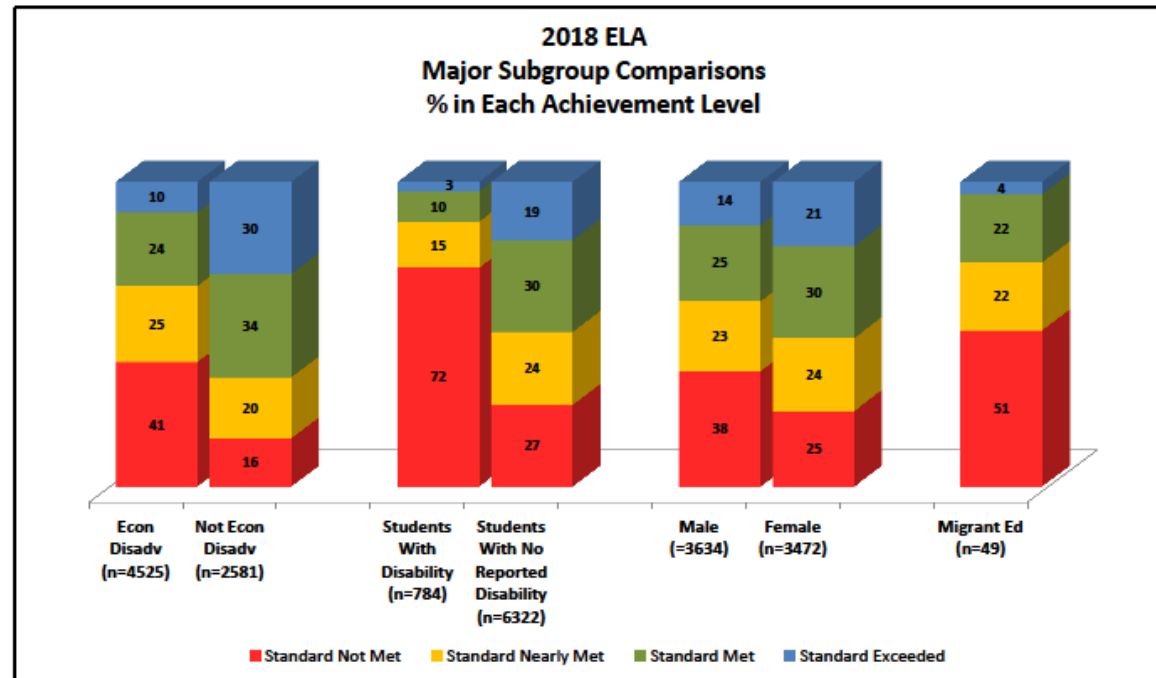

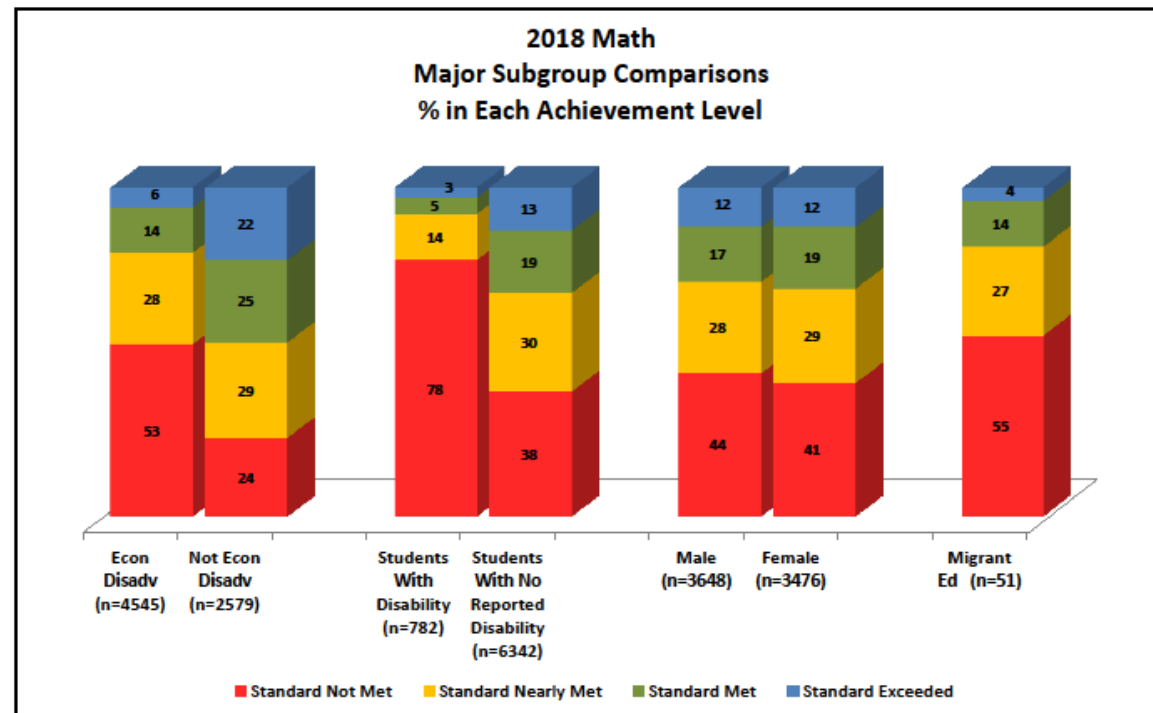


# 2018 ELA MAJOR SUBGROUPS

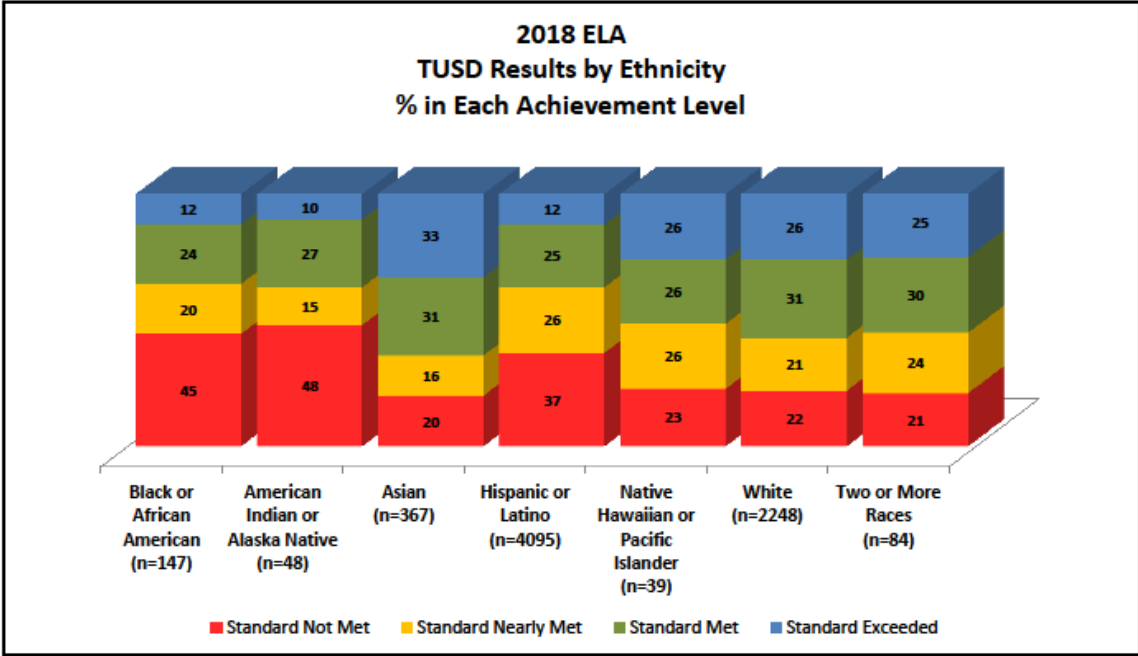




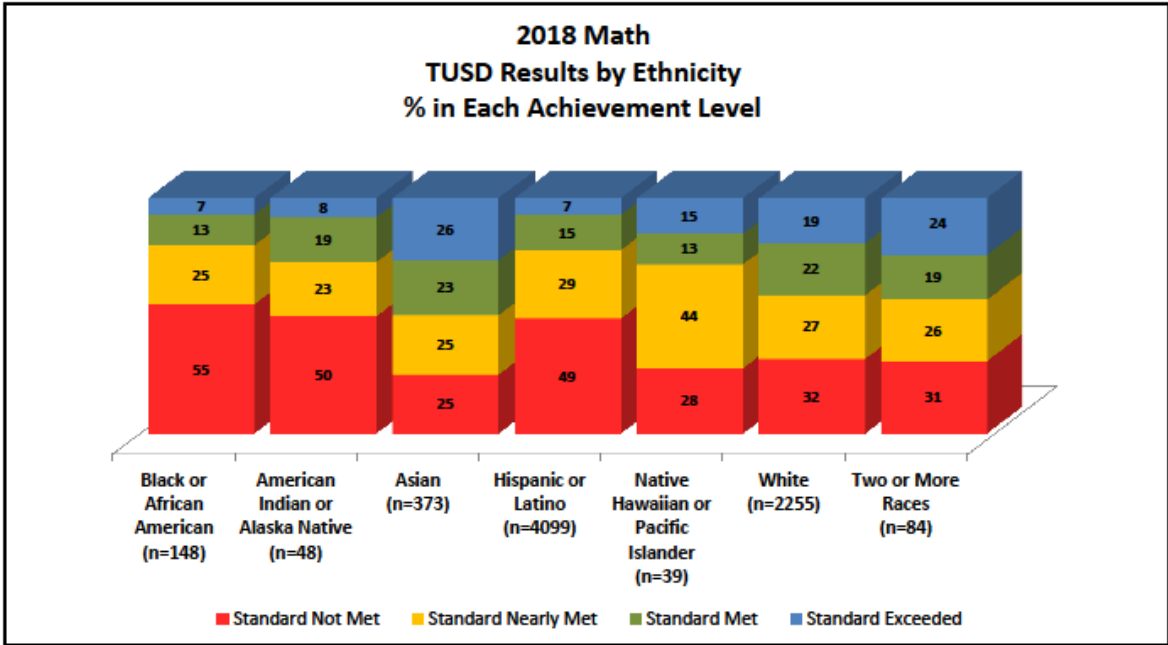
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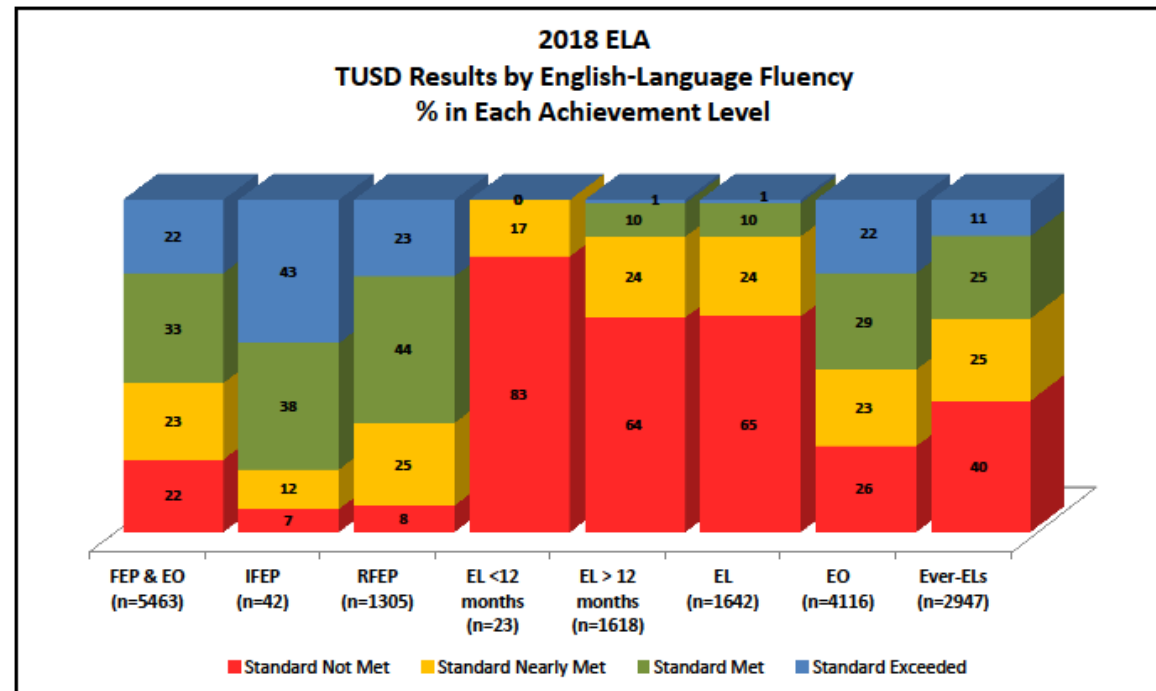
# ELA RESULTS BY ETHNICITY



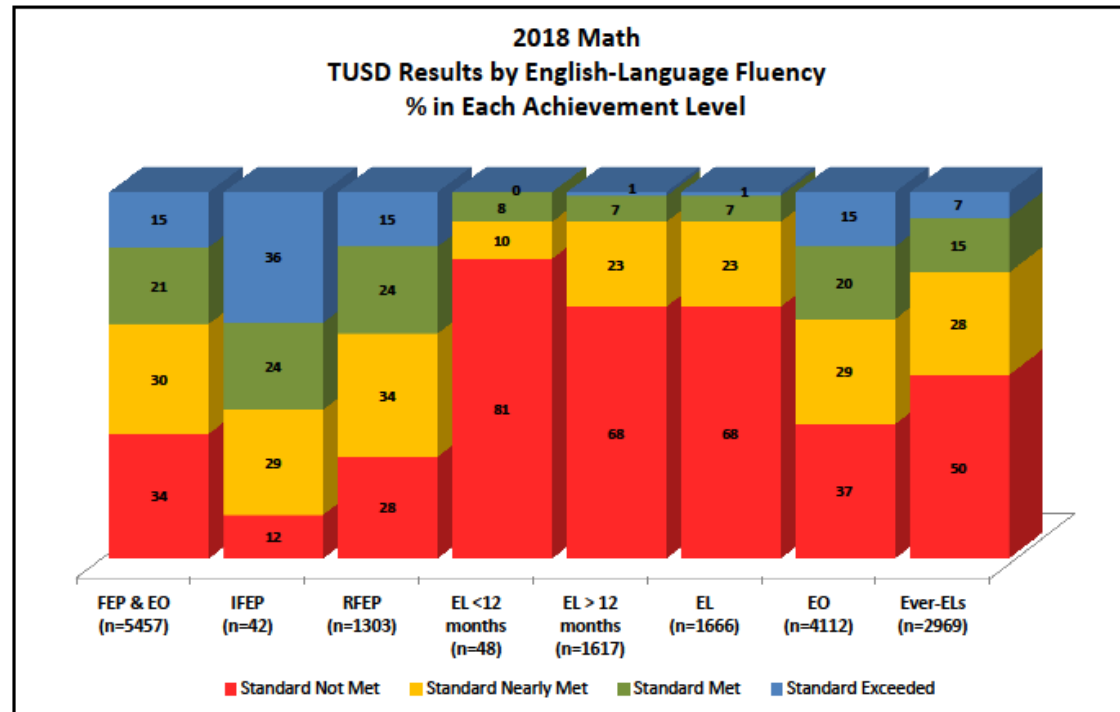
# MATHEMATICS RESULTS BY ETHNICITY

# EARLY ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (EAP) STATUS

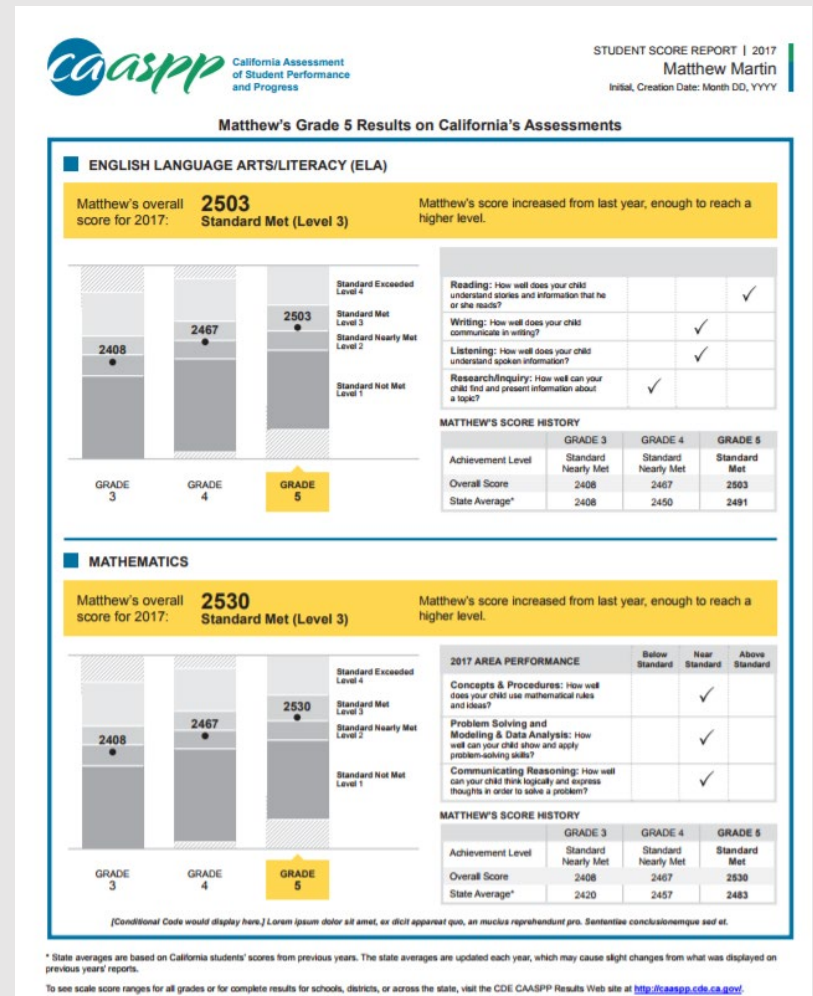
- Ready – Standards Exceeded
  - Ready for English and/or mathematics college-level coursework.
- Conditionally Ready – Standards Met
  - Conditionally Ready for English and/or mathematics college-level coursework. Students earning this status can be exempt from the CSU's placement test and Early Start Program by taking an approved course and earning a grade C or better.
- Not Yet Ready – Standards Nearly Met/Not Met
  - Not demonstrating readiness for English and/or mathematics college-level coursework
