Bullying means the repeated behavior of one or more of the following:

- Physical harm: examples include pushing, hitting, breaking objects, taking or damaging another person's belongings...
- Verbal: teasing, name calling, threats, intimidation, rumors, gossip, etc.
- Emotional: examples include excluding, telling lies to hurt someone's reputation and humiliating someone publicly...
- Cyberbullying: examples include using social networking sites to send mean text messages, post videos or photos that ridicule someone and spreading rumors..
