Items required to complete an application:

- Child's birth documentation (and birth documentation for all children in household)
- Child's immunization record, physical, dental and primary physician information
- Family Income Verification— Bring all that apply:
 - TANF Passport to Services/Notice of Action
 - SSI, Disability, Unemployment, Child Support
 - 2019 Income Tax Form showing all members in household
 - If working, most current paycheck stub (must show year-to date income)
 - Student aid grants/scholarships
