



Turlock Unified School District's Festival on the Green

Vendor Rules

All basic booth spaces are 12'D x 12'W. Food menus must be approved by Turlock Unified School District (TUSD).

Note: We only provide the space. It is your responsibility to provide your own table, chairs, awning, tie-downs, or anything you might need for the booth space. NO PROPANE canisters of any sort or size is allowed on school property. TUSD shall not be responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged property.

RULES OF VENDOR BOOTH SPACES:

1. All vendors are responsible for their own sales tax, business licenses and permits in order to sell at this event. All licenses, permits and forms must be on display at the vendor's booth space.
2. Area around space must be left clean and free of all paper and trash.
3. Liability insurance is the responsibility of the vendor. TUSD shall not be responsible for lost, stolen or damaged merchandise and/or equipment.
4. No cars or trucks will be allowed on the campus after space is set up.
5. All vendors will receive a vehicle pass to enter the area for the purpose of assembly and disassembly.
6. Sale hours will be Saturday, March 21, 2020, 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. You may begin setting up your space for business between 7:00 am ~ 9:00 am, Saturday morning. We require all vendors to be set up and ready for business by 9:00 am. In addition, all vendors are required to stop selling and close their space at 4:00 pm.
7. No alcoholic beverages allowed inside booths at any time by anyone. All vendors must conduct themselves in a professional manner. If vendor fails to comply they may be asked to close and risk further participation in TUSD events.
8. If you decide to close early, you WILL NOT be able to bring any vehicle on campus until after the official close time of 4:00 pm.
9. There are no dogs/animals allowed at the festival or in the festival area. (Seeing Eye Dogs, Service Dogs).
10. TUSD is not responsible for damages, loses or inclement weather. We encourage you to not leave valuable equipment, supplies, or merchandise in your booth unattended.
11. There will be no refunds for rain or other act, either man made or natural or if the space reservation is cancelled after Friday, March 13, 2020.

12. A complete application and all fees must be received no later than Friday, February 28, 2020. Applications are considered complete and your vendor space will be assigned when all permits, payments and necessary documents are received. Vendors may not set up until all of the above conditions are met.
13. All decisions made by TUSD are final. Vendors must comply with all laws and regulations.
14. The sale of meats, soft drinks and/or water will not be permitted by any food vendor, other than those approved.
15. Anyone dispensing paper products or the disposal of liquid by-products must be responsible for litter containers.
16. Any food items not listed on the original application will not be approved for sale by TUSD.
17. Each food vendor will be required by the Stanislaus County Health Department to fill out and return all appropriate reports and permits. In your packet you will find a copy of an application for temporary food permit. Please return to TUSD with your application prior to Tuesday, February 28, 2020.
18. All vendors are expected to be ready for inspection by Stanislaus County Health Department on Saturday by 9:00 am. Vendors not ready for inspection at this time run the risk of not being approved for participation in the Festival on the Green.
